

# Voki Lesson Plan



**Lesson title:** Math

**Lesson title:** Multiplication songs

**Grade Level:** Elementary School

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**Objectives:**

Students will:

1. Learn the multiplication tables
2. Memorize the multiplication tables

**Materials:**

1. List of familiar songs
2. Multiplication table
3. Voki.com

**Procedure:**

1. Explain to your students that they will have to memorize the multiplication table.
2. Hand out the multiplication table sheet.
3. Explain to your students that it is easier to remember the multiplication table by singing.
4. Give an example by singing the 3 times table. As you sing each song, put up a finger for each number. For example, for  $3 \times 1$ , you hold up 1 finger; for  $3 \times 2$ , you hold up 2 fingers.

Here's a list of possible songs that you can sing to:

- 3 times table – Jingle Bells
  - 4 times table – Row, Row, Row Your Boat
  - 5 times table – No need for a nursery rhyme
  - 6 times table – Happy Birthday
  - 7 times table - Twinkle, Twinkle Little Star
  - 8 times table – She'll Be Coming Round the Mountain
  - 9 times table – Yankee Doodle Dandy
5. After you feel that your students have a grasp of the song, introduce a math problem. For example,  $3 \times 3$ . Explain to them how to sing to the 3 times table up to the third finger.

6. Introduce other multiplication songs to your students. Have them create a Voki singing one of the multiplication songs.
