Voki Lesson Plan



Class Title: Math

Lesson Title: Multiplication Fun with Voki

Grade Level: 3rd

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Description: Students will learn about multiplication while having fun on Voki. Through repetition and creative explanations presented at the end of the exercise, students will have the chance to know and understand multiplication facts. At the end of the exercise, students evaluate each other and offer constructive feedback.

Objectives:

Students will:

- 1. Explain how to multiply by the assigned facts.
- 2. Recall multiplication facts.
- 3. Design a Voki presentation to show their knowledge of the assigned facts.
- 4. Evaluate their own Voki presentation and peers' Voki presentations.

Materials:

- 1. A computer for each student
- 2. Paper, pencils, and markers
- 3. Voki.com or Voki Classroom (example:

http://www.voki.com/pickup.php?scid=4386055&height=400&width=300)

Class Duration: 1 Week

Activities:

- 1. Begin by reviewing the rules for multiplying with the students.
- 2. Brainstorm ideas together as a group for tips, tricks, and ideas to help students remember specific multiplication facts.
- 3. Introduce the above pre-made Voki presentation for multiplying by three.
- 4. Explain to students that they will create a Voki presentation to teach someone the assigned multiplication facts. They will include the rule for multiplying by that number and the facts in that table. They may also include tips, tricks, and ideas to help others learn the facts.
- 5. Have students create a script for their Voki presentation.

- 6. Have students work in small groups to peer critique scripts before actually creating the Voki presentations. Students will help each other fix any mistakes or improve the message.
- 7. Teacher will conference with each student before the student makes the Voki presentation.
- 8. Show students how to create a Voki by choosing and customizing a character and giving the character a voice.
 - a. Students will use the text to voice feature or record their script to add voice.
 - b. Students will then choose a background.
 - c. The last step will be to click on Publish to email the Voki or get a code for sharing it.
 - d. If using Voki Classroom, the teacher will be able to approve each Voki after a student has saved it. Once approved, students will be able to grab the embed code of the sharing link.
- 9. Each student will view his/her presentation to analyze and evaluate for accuracy.
- 10. Students will view other Voki presentations to analyze and evaluate for accuracy. If using Voki Classroom, the approved Vokis will all be on the lesson's Web page.
